

# DIRTY FLIRTY BIRDS SUPPLY LIST

Sketch book or Journal (or papers to sketch and draw with)

Assorted graphite pencils: 2b, hb, 6b are good choices

Assorted pens for journaling/sketching

Small flat brush, assorted round and medium sized brushes.

**Flat scraper:** catalyst wedge, old credit card, plaster scraping tool

**Basics:** Water container, Palette paper, paper towels, spray bottle

**Water soluble pencils:** Stabilo Pencil in Black or a Jerry's Jumbo Jet Black pencils (from Jerry's Artarama)

**Optional:** Colored pencils or water color pencils, Neo Color II Crayons

**Acrylic paints:** White and black Soft Body acrylic paint along with 4-5 of your favorite colors to get started. For ease of mixing you may want to include primary colors along with a couple extra colors that you just can't live without or find hard to mix, such as teal, magenta, green gold, Indian yellow hue.

**Other acrylic paint I find helpful:** Paynes' gray (any), Quinacridone nickel azo gold (Golden) or Australian sienna (Matisse), a small tube of gold (Pebeo has a great range of iridescent/metallic colors).

**Acrylic Mediums:** Gesso, white and black, Glazing Medium, Fluid Matte Medium, Modeling Paste, Optional: Iridescent medium, ultra matte medium

**Surfaces:** 1-2 8x8 cradled wood surfaces, 1-2 12 x 16 cradled wood (7/8 or 1 5/8s profile). You could also use MDF panels or Hardbord panels by Ampersand. 12 x 24 or 12 x 36 canvas

**Papers:** Light weight collage papers, deli paper, patterned tissue paper. Any other papers you'd like to include (gelli print papers or painted papers).

**Stencils:** A few of your favorite stencils and or stamps.

**Enhancers:** 2 (20 gauge) Fine Line Applicator filled with carbon black fluid acrylic and titanium white fluid acrylic.

**Finishing:** Spray Varnish in Matte (Krylon or Golden)

**Optional:** Liquitex liquid matte and satin varnish
